

DELAWARE BRIDGE AND SHOWING PHILLIPSBURG, N. J., FROM EASTON, PA.

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This structure replaces a covered wooden indee of three's spans, each about 155 feet clear, supported by two bollow piers, 35 feet by 55 feet and two abutments. Built in 1805, at time of removal being next to the oldest, if not the oldest wooden highway Bridge in the U. S. Dimensions of grearner bridge a cantelever bridge 550 feet between end piers, two snore arms, 125 feet each, suspended span 50 feet. Trusses 36 feet, centers extreme width 56 feet 8 in., material med. steel, built 1895, elevation of Cap Stone on pier 187-87 feet above mean tide at Sandy Hook.

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
